

**Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting
Violation Failure to Submit a Surface Water Monthly
Operating Report (SWMOR)**

MARTINDALE WSC, PWS ID TX0280013 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems that treat surface water and/or ground water under the direct influence of surface water are required to submit monthly operating reports with operational data of the treatment, disinfection and quality of the water provided to their customers.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for surface water constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

What is being done:

A second member of our staff shall be trained to do the SWMOR (monthly water quality report) to provide a backup. The person responsible for the report was in the hospital/physical rehab during most of January and February. The two reports were submitted to the TCEQ on March 9, 2026. The TCEQ considered the submittals to be late.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
